


## THE PILOT SITE

In Gökova, biodiversity is particularly threatened by urbanization, mass tourism and intensive agriculture. Through the Green Light protocol, the stakeholders have worked together with Alliance members and artists to propose a vision and strategy for the site. We propose actions to recover coastal wetland functionality, an ecotourism attraction and a stopover for migratory waterbirds.

## Phase 1 (2024-2026)

• Restoration of the dunes, waterbodies, and vegetation
• Construction of an observatory tower, walking path and information panels
